Roommate selection tools in our assignment system require a gender match within a roommate group and when assigning a student to a room or suite with other residents.

By selecting interest in Gender Inclusive Housing below, you will only be eligible to select roommates who have also indicated interest in Gender Inclusive Housing.

Gender-inclusive housing is designed to create inclusive communities for students of varying gender identities. Gender identities are numerous and include man, woman, transgender and gender queer, among many others. The Gender Inclusive (GI) housing option provides a safe and inclusive environment for trans, gender-fluid, gender non-conforming and non-binary students. Gender-inclusive housing is not co-ed housing. Gender Inclusive assignments are made based on individual student requests (room type, Living Learning Community, first-year or continuing student status).

Before you sign up for a GI housing option, ask yourself if you can you commit "yes" to these statements:

- I understand that Gender Inclusive housing is designed to create inclusive communities for students of varying gender identities. Gender identities are numerous and include man, woman, transgender and gender queer, among many others. Gender Inclusive housing is intended to be more than co-ed housing.
